## How do our three distinct oil grades differ in production?

We offer a specialized range of Organic Hemp Seed Oils, each tailored to specific industrial and consumer needs. While all originate from *Cannabis sativa L.*, the extraction and filtration methods vary to achieve different flavor and stability profiles.

- **Cold Pressed Hemp Seed Oil (Raw/Unrefined):** Extracted from the whole seed at temperatures below **40°C**. It is physically filtered to remove solids while retaining its deep green color and “raw” botanical aroma.
- **Refined Hemp Seed Oil:** This grade undergoes a natural physical refining process (bleaching and deodorizing with organic-approved clays). It results in a clear, pale yellow oil with a neutral scent and a higher smoke point.
- **Hemp Heart Oil (Hulled Seed Oil):** A boutique oil pressed exclusively from the **white inner hearts** (hulled seeds). It is the “extra virgin” equivalent of the hemp world—extremely mild, light in color, and exceptionally creamy.

**A:** No. Hemp Seed Oil is pressed from the seeds, which do not contain THC or CBD. These compounds are found in the flowers and leaves of the plant. Our oil is purely a nutritional and lipid-based product.

**Q: Why would I choose Refined Hemp Oil over Cold Pressed?**

**A:** Refined oil is preferred for cosmetic formulations (where a green color or grassy smell would interfere with the final product) and for culinary applications requiring a higher heat tolerance.

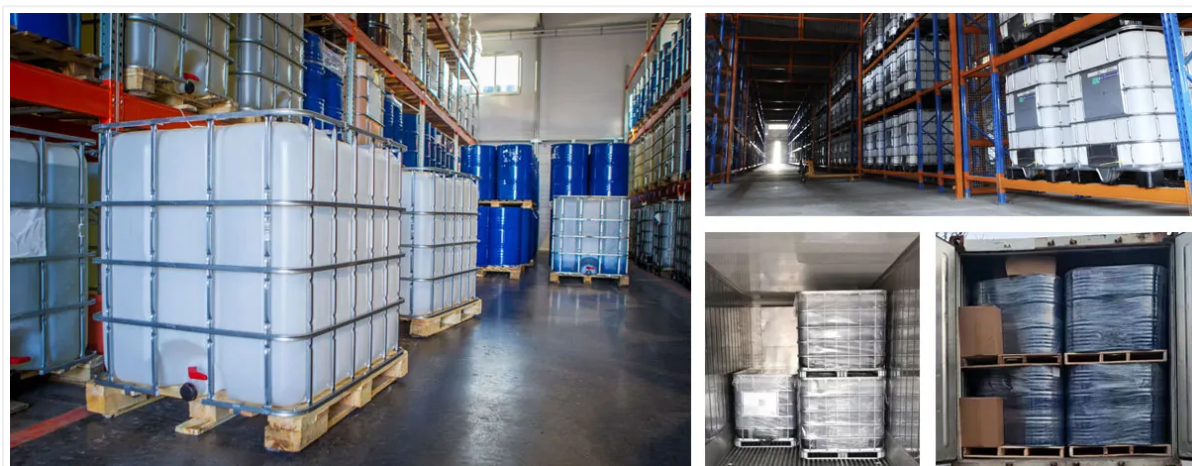
**Q: Is Hemp Heart Oil nutritionally superior to Whole Seed Oil?**

**Q: How should I manage the storage and shelf life?**

**A:** Hemp oil is sensitive to light and heat. We ship in amber or opaque containers. Once received, store in a cool, dark place. Once opened, **refrigeration is highly recommended** to prevent oxidation of the delicate Omega-3 chains.
